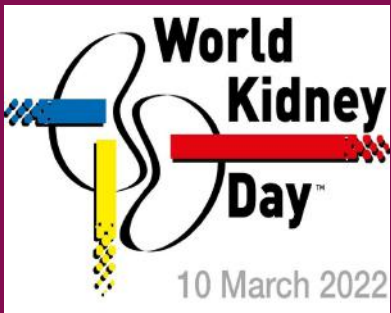
400th Prakash Parv Varsh of Shri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji
