

# From editor's desk:

The year bygone gave the Society a plethora of achievements, moments of extreme contentment and a lot of landmarks to feel proud about.

The Society took a giant leap forwards by fulfilling a long cherished dream of their patrons and guardians when the foundation was laid for their 12th hospital at the holy town of Vrindavan, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh. The Society has now breached the State barrier by entering Uttar Pradesh and is now a pan India entity.

Society's 10th charitable hospital was dedicated to the humanity at Gangotri Dham on 29th September 2021 thus marking another milestone and inching closer to the vision of having modern health facilities at all the four Char Dhams of Uttarakhand and then by December 11th hospital was under the Society's kitty, when as per the wish of Swamiji of Sadhana Kendra Ashram, Dumet, Dehradun, his charitable hospital came under the Society umbrella.

In the first quarter, COVID second wave rattled humanity leading to suffering and overburdening of health infrastructure. The Society with all their might and resources played a critical role in serving the COVID patients in their hospitals as well as their teams ventured into the community to reach the neglected and impoverished brethren. To address the issue of oxygen deficit, Dharmawala hospital became equipped with a 250 LPM Oxygen generation plant donated by SEWA international thus marking a new chapter in the illustrious history of the facility.

The commencement of USG facility at Pipalkoti hospital was another milestone achieved, thus making it the third hospital of the Society to do so and initiation of spine surgery at Dharmawala was another remarkable deed which shows our deep commitment to make available a facility which is usually out of bound for the deprived and those hailing from low socioeconomic strata.

In an another first, Society came out with their first annual calendar thus marking a watershed moment in their illustrious history

The services and facilities being offered by the Society hospitals scaled new peaks and we had a lot of all-time highs, including registrations, USG scans, level II pregnancy scans, CT scans, lab investigations to name a few.

One rare feat was achieved when our Pipalkoti hospital team reached through treacherous terrain and dangerous trek to a remote, inaccessible and hilly village named Kimana located 12 km away and where no medical team had ever set foot since independence. The community outreach agenda of the Society was fulfilled when all the hospitals conducted Community Interaction Drive in their respective areas. The overwhelming response of the community to the drive validated the confidence and belief the Society hospitals have instilled in them with their selfless service.

The year ahead will bring more laurels to the Society and we will keep treading the path of Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa.



# Society's 10th Hospital

**Gangotri Dham hospital was started in the holy** presence and blessings of Pujniya Swami Raghavendranand Ji of Ishavasyam Ashram, Gangotri Dham and Dr Anuj Singhal, Secretary, **SVHM Society, senior management and staff of** temple committee, pilgrims, saints and local police officials. This 12 bedded hospital established at Gangotri Dham is offering totally free round the clock services thus becoming the only hospital in the area to do so. The hospital is equipped with facilities like fully equipped ICU, Emergency, Digital X-ray, ECG, Laboratory, Pharmacy, Male and Female wards.

# Society's 11th Hospital

As per the request of Swami Udasin Ji's of Sadhana Kendra Ashram, the Society took over the functioning of the Udasinacharya Shrichandra Charitable Health Centre, Dumet, Dehradun. Sadhana Kendra Ashram is running a charitable school, as well as a charitable health centre and in addition, does numerous other charitable activities. Noteworthy the ashram has been regularly helping our Society in various health programmes and initiatives. The health centre has a general OPD, a Dental wing, a well equipped laboratory and free pharmacy.

## Upcoming Society's 300 bedded Multi & Superspecialty Hospital at Vrindavan

Among vedic rituals and customs, the foundation laying ceremony was held for the 12th hospital of the Society at Vrindavan, Brajdham, Uttar Pradesh. The 7 acres facility named "Keshav Madhav Chikitsalaya" will be an ideal destination for highest quality health care with charity offering the entire spectrum of services under one umbrella. The hospital will be totally free for the saint community, widows as well as for people from the lower socioeconomic strata. It will be a boon to the pilgrims and other people living in and around the region thus helping in fulfilling the "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" motto of the Society. The Society hopes to make the hospital operational by Diwali next year.

The cost of spinal surgery at Dharmawala Hospital is only 5 - 10% of the total cost as compared to the other hospitals.
