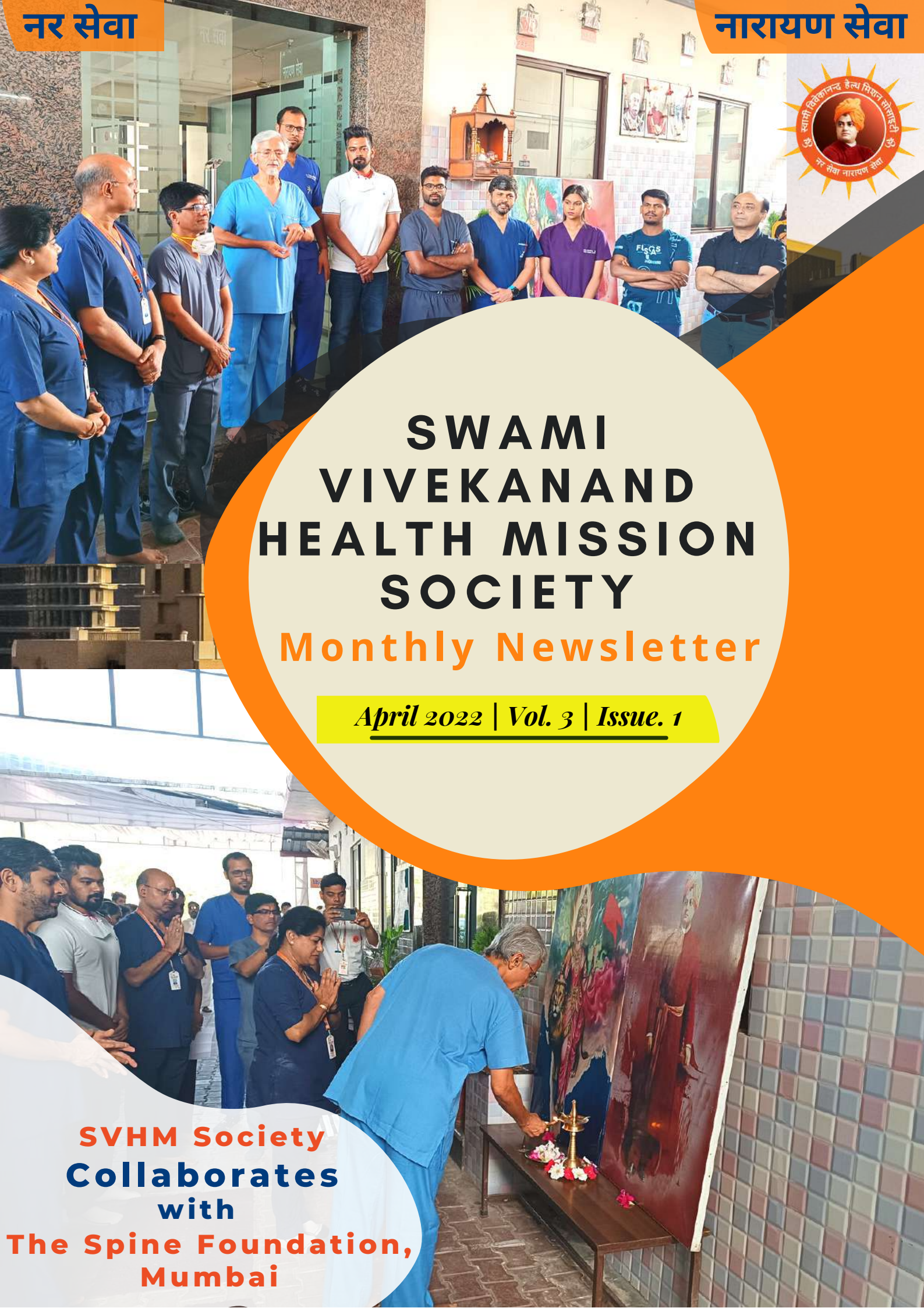

Spine Surgery Underway

SVHM Society has entered into a collaboration with The Spine Foundation to provide affordable and accessible spine care to the underprivileged and needy patients. The Spine Foundation is the social arm of the Spine Unit which was initiated at the prestigious KEM Hospital (MCGM), Mumbai in 1988 under the guidance of Dr. Shekhar Y. Bhojraj, as the first of its kind in the country. The foundation considers it a social responsibility and a moral obligation to make spine care affordable and easily accessible to the non-affording millions.

Dr Tejasvi Agarwal of the foundation had already started spine surgery and OPD at our Dharmawala hospital from Feb 2022 onwards and was instrumental in formulating this collaboration. The Mumbai team paid us a visit on 23rd April and were impressed with our Society's charitable work. The Founder and Trustee, Dr. Shekhar Y. Bhojraj while addressing the staff of Dharmawala hospital gave an overview of The Spine Foundation journey followed by a presentation with success stories. Other members of the visiting team were: Dr Premik Nagad, Dr Hari Krishnan, Dr Shiva Kumar, Dr Deependra Tomar, Dr Dimple and Mr. Mahesh Palan.
