## Success Stories - Shri Kedarnath Dham Hospital

Though there are nearly 4000 plus emergencies dealt successfully by our Dham hospitals and each one has its own narrative but we are sharing a few of those success stories which will touch your heart.

- A 60 year old female pilgrim fell from a height of approximately 250 feet after being hit by a mule during her journey.
- With the blessings of Shri Kedar Baba the patient survived the fall and was brought to our hospital in a critical condition with injuries over her head and both lower limbs.
- Patient was immediately shifted to ICU and stabilized with necessary medications and her wounds over head were sutured (27 stitches).
- The patient remained under continuous strict monitoring and care which led to the improvement within a few hours.
- A 62 year old female pilgrim from Madhya Pradesh presented with very high fever (106.8 F) associated with vigorous shivering and altered behaviour. Her BP was also low and SpO2 was 56%.
- Patient was immediately shifted to ICU and given oxygen support.
- Continuous vigilant monitoring and care led to improvement after a few hours with her temperature returning to normal, BP stabilizing and SpO2 also improving.
- A group of 4 young female pilgrims from Delhi were injured as the tent in which they were staying collapsed due to heavy snowfall thus exposing them to the harsh winter conditions.
- Learning about the mishap, our hospital staff braving the rough conditions rushed to the site and brought all 4 to our hospital carrying one of them in their arms.
- All 4 were in a state of hypothermia (low body temperature condition) as well as were having multiple injuries.
- All were provided with warmth, necessary treatment and support and then discharged in stable condition.
- A 59 year old female pilgrim injured her left arm as a result of fall while on her way to the temple.
- Presented to us with immense pain and swelling of the left arm. X-ray revealed fracture of her left arm bone. The patient underwent closed reduction and a U shaped plaster slab was applied on her left arm.
- Relieved of her pain and discomfort, the patient was then discharged in a stable condition.


- A 72 year old male pilgrim hailing from Mumbai was brought with complaints of difficulty in breathing, severe chest pain and headache.
- The patient was immediately attended to and necessary treatment was given leading to improvement in his condition.
- The relatives of the patient were full of gratitude to the entire team of hospital and the Society. They further said that this hospital has proved to be Sanjeevani (a lifesaving medicinal herb mentioned in "Ramayan") for the pilgrims and the local folk. They never thought that such medical facilities would be available in this remote location and high altitude.
- A Sr. Orthopaedician from Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh presented in our hospital with complaints of severe headache, neck pain and a low SPO2 level. He was immediately given Oxygen support along with other necessary treatment.
- Once his condition improved including the SPO2 level, he was discharged in a stable condition.
- Being an owner of two hospitals himself, the patient was overwhelmed with the overall facilities available in our hospital.
- He saluted the Society's initiative of operating a wellequipped hospital at such high altitude and offered to serve the Society hospitals whenever needed.
- A 40 year old female pilgrim from Maharashtra was brought with complaints of loose stool, vomiting and weakness since the last two days.
- The patient was found to be suffering from Acute Gastroenteritis with dehydration.
- She was given required treatment and once stabilized was then discharged.
- A 48 year old female pilgrim from Gorakhpur was brought with complaints of shortness of breath, severe giddiness and restlessness in our hospital.
- Her SPO2 was below 70% and she was diagnosed as suffering from Acute Mountain Sickness. She was quickly attended to and stabilized by providing immediate Oxygen support and other necessary treatment.
- Once stabilized the patient was discharged in healthy condition

## Another milestone achieved by conducting first successful "Hip Joint Replacement Surgery"

- A 23 year old labourer hailing from a slum of Roorkee was crippled due to fracture of his right hip bone as a result of an unfortunate accident 2 yrs. ago. The treatment required a total hip replacement surgery, cost of which was beyond his reach due to the poor socioeconomic background.
- He continued to suffer from the ailment until he attended one of our outreach camps and was then referred by one of the camp volunteers to our hospital. The Society then approached one of our donors who readily agreed to bear the expense of the surgery.
- He was operated successfully and was relieved of his malady and disability.





