Content

From editor's desk:

The quarter was a medley of accomplishments, new initiatives, fruition, celebrations and festivities.

The quarter began with the roll out of the next phase of the Society run Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme with the support of UJVN limited. The high point and a huge encouragement for us was the presence of the top brass of UJVN limited including their MD Shri Sandeep Singhal in the inauguration event held on 9th of October at Dharmawala hospital. It is noteworthy that Society ran the first phase of this program as a pilot project which was successful and inspired by this, the next phase was started.

The quarter saw curtain down for the season of Society's three Dham hospitals which yet again achieved new highs and served more than 1.6 lakh pilgrims. The teams departed with a resolute commitment to return again next year and keep the flag of SVHM Society flying high.

Another proud moment was when our Shri Badrinath Dham hospital was identified to remain in alert mode as an authorized facility (safe house) during the visit of Her Excellency the President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu to Shri Badrinath Dham temple. Again, during the visit of Chairman and Managing Director of Reliance Industries Limited Shri Mukesh Ambani's to Shri Kedarnath Dham and Shri Badrinath Dham shrines, our hospitals were identified and requested by the Company to remain prepared for any kind of medical emergency etc.

In another noteworthy development, Society expanded the spectrum of services by starting a Physiotherapy facility at Barkot Hospital. Another significant development was related to Society run Pipalkoti hospital, where the process of up-gradation to a 50 bedded secondary care level facility was formalised with land being acquired for the same near the existing building. Similarly, the process of up gradation of Shri Badrinath Dham hospital is underway with kind support of Seth Mansingka Trust.

Another achievement was the inauguration of the Soft Tissue Laser Machine in the Dental Department of Dharmawala Hospital.

November month saw the elite team of The Spine Foundation Mumbai led by Dr Shekhar Y Bhojraj descend down at Dharmawala hospital for conducting the biannual Spine Surgery camp with generous support from HOPE foundation, Dehradun. Similarly, the fortnightly urology camps at Dharmawala Hospital continued providing advanced surgery facilities to the community, notably in one such camp, a very complex, expensive and advanced surgery named Lap Ureteric Re-implantation was performed completely free of cost.

Society hospitals celebrated all the festivals of the quarter with traditional enthusiasm, fervour and gaiety with every staff indulging in festivities and jollity. The coming quarter will be filled with more achievements and accomplishments and with the blessings of Bhagwan Shri Ram, the Society will continue to follow its path of 'Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa.'

Founded in the year 2012 by a group of young Doctors and some philanthropists, Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is continuing its mission of providing high quality charitable health care to mankind. The Society started its journey by establishing their first charitable project in the form of a small dispensary at Dharmawala, a tribal dominated village, situated 40 km from Dehradun, Uttarakhand and bordering the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

The self-belief of the Society to provide quality health care to the deprived, tribes, pilgrims and needy along with strong willed approach led to establishment of more hospitals in phases as well as the up gradation of the small dispensary of Dharmawala to a full-fledged multi-specialty hospital.

The Society with its vision and mission as the guiding principles also established charitable hospitals in three of the Char Dham's of the state of Uttarakhand. These are at Shri Badrinath Dham, Shri Kedarnath Dham and Gangotri Dham and are fully equipped with ICU facilities with staff trained in dealing with the health problems of high altitude. The vast number of pilgrims visiting these shrines

from all over the world used to suffer because of non-availability of quality health care and the morbidity and mortality at these shrines was worrying, the establishment of Society's hospital at these Dham's brought down the rates by 90%. Presently, 12 charitable hospitals are being run by the Society, out of which 11 are in Uttarakhand and one is in Delhi.

The Society apart from its charitable hospitals is also involved in other philanthropic activities like conducting community medical camps in remote, hilly and difficult to reach areas (during COVID wave also), education activities, making community self-reliant via Swavalamban Abhiyaan and community health programmes which encompass five programmes in itself (Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme, Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme, Menstrual Hygiene Programme, Community Mental Health Programme and Oral, Head and Neck Cancer Awareness, Screening and Treatment Programme).

The "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" motto of the Society has been and will always remain the essence of all our endeavours to serve humanity.

- SVHM Society with the support from UJVN Limited rolled out Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme under their social outreach intervention.
- A formal inauguration was held on the 9th of October in the esteemed presence of the Managing Director UJVNL Shri Sandeep Singhal; Director Operations Shri Puroshottam Singh; General Manager Shri Vivek Atreya; Medical Director Dharmawala hospital Dr. Pramod Sharma and Secretary, SVHM Society Dr. Anuj Singhal.
- The programme being implemented in tribal dominated villages aims to reach about 20,000 beneficiaries. Under this programme, free haemoglobin test of all children aged between 6 months to 5 years and women of all age groups will be done by house-to-house visits along with iron and vitamin C supplementation to Anaemic beneficiaries free of cost. Deworming with Albendazole will also be done along with focussed individual / group counselling related to nutrition and hygiene.

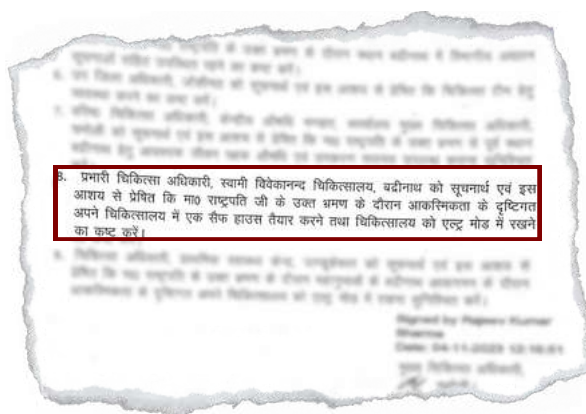

18 November, Dharmawala: A total of 7 complex spine surgeries were performed in the camp by Dr. Shekhar Y. Bhojraj, Sr. Spine Surgeon and Trustee of The Spine Foundation and his team. HOPE Foundation contributed for the camp through their philanthropic gesture



- Out of 7 surgeries done, one was of a Scoliosis patient, which happened to be the first surgery of its kind in Uttarakhand.
- For this surgery, a special type of neuro-monitoring equipment was needed which had to be outsourced specially for this procedure.
- Normally, the cost of such surgery amounts to 10 to 15 lakh rupees, which was done totally free in our hospital with support of HOPE Foundation, Dehradun.



Fortnightly Urology Camps



Dharmawala: A total of 51 surgeries were successfully performed during the quarter by the dedicated team of Urologists. In one such camp a complex surgery called "Lap Ureteric Re-implantation Surgery", in which a cut ureter (a tubular structure transporting urine from the kidney to the urinary bladder) was connected to the urinary bladder was done. Such complex and highly expensive surgery which is available only in tertiary care hospitals was done totally free of cost at Dharmawala hospital.
