SUCCESS STORY

PETSHAL

Case 1

A 38 years old female presented in the emergency with h/o fall from 15 feet and injuries over face, back and chest. On examination she was found to have fractured her L1 vertebral spine, 1st and 2nd ribs of left side and right zygomatic arch.

Under the expert online guidance of Spinal surgeon, Neurosurgeon and Orthopaedician she was conservatively managed until stable and then referred to a higher centre for further care and management.

Case 2

A 12 yrs old village girl presented with injury over right elbow, her x ray revealed right olecranon bone fracture. She was immediately given emergency care, plaster applied and was then referred to a higher centre for needful.

AYURVEDA DEPARTMENT DHARMAWALA

Pemphigus vulgaris case:

The department had a 19 yrs old male patient of Pemphigus vulgaris who had marked relief in his signs and symptoms after treatment. He had been suffering from this rare autoimmune disorder since last 5 years with no relief even after having taken numerous consultations at multiple clinics and hospitals . Pemphigus vulgaris causes painful blistering on the skin and mucous membranes.

The patient was treated with oral drugs, bath and sitz bath. In about two months time the old lesions began to heal, there was reduction in frequency and numbers of new lesions and recurrence of old healed lesions also stopped. After about 5 months the patient has largely recovered and there are no new lesions as well as no recurrence.

On the auspicious occasion of Maha Kumbh festival , a Netra Kumbh dedicated for eye related diseases is being organized in Haridwar by Saksham organization. A total of seven such centers have been set up in various parts of the city and one such dedicated Netra Kumbh center was inaugurated at our Haridwar hospital on 16-03-2021. This center continued it's exemplary service in April month too.

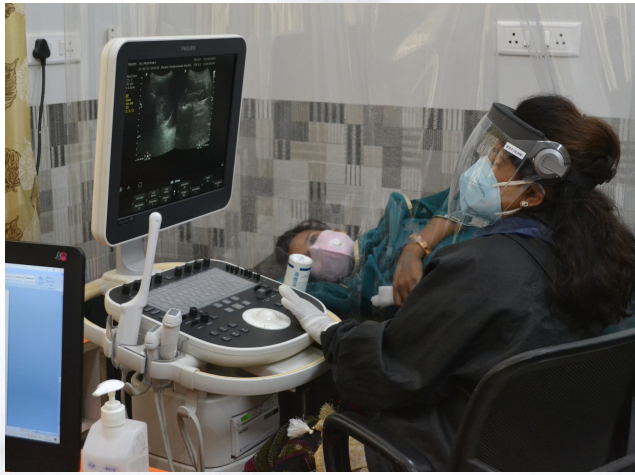

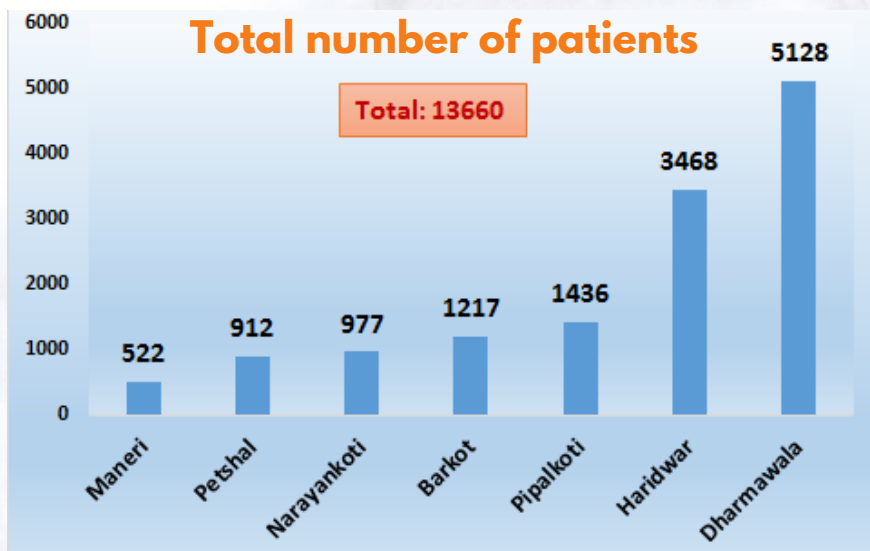

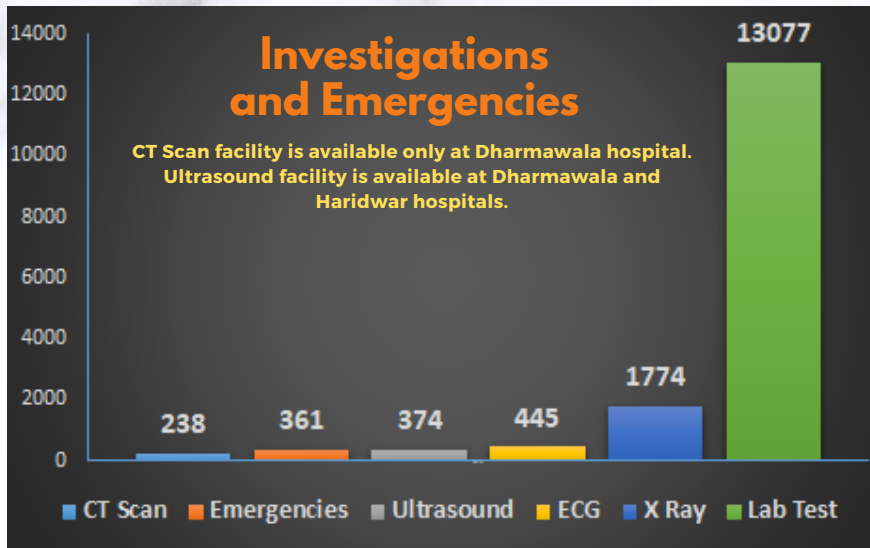

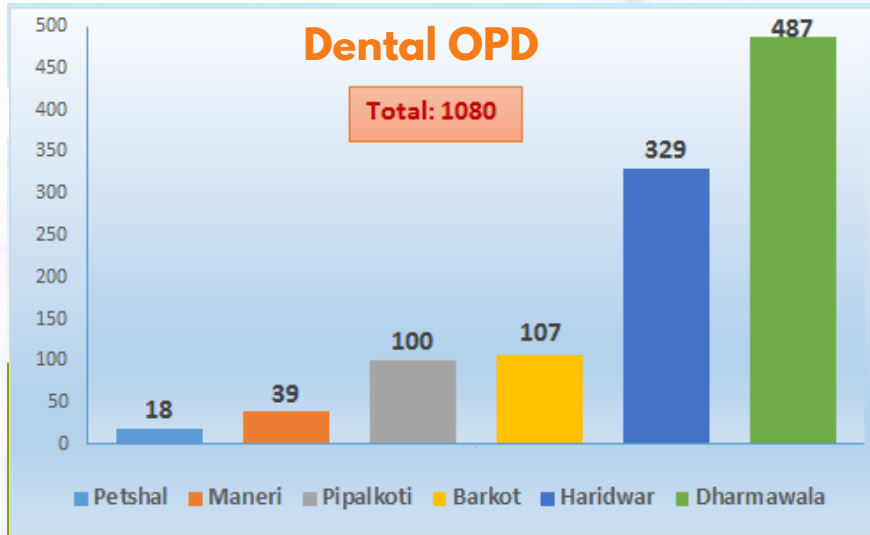
