COMMUNITY MEDICAL CAMPS

Pipalkoti

Total 9 camps catering to 31 villages were conducted with 1177 beneficiaries

Pipalkoti (Badrinath Marg) Hospital organized a total of 9 community medical camps in Pakhi, Syun, Badaganv, Harmani, Tangadi, Baula, Sainji, Kimana and Saikot villages of block Joshimath and Dasholi of Chamoli District situated at distances ranging from a nearest of 8 km to farthest of 47 km from our hospital. These much needed camps were held between 14th to 31st of May respectively.

These villages were selected on the basis of their inaccessibility, no nearby health facility, difficult to reach location and prevailing health problems. Also these camps were organised in a manner so that they could cater to many other nearby villages. Prior information about the camp was already communicated to the main as well as surrounding villages. Villagers routinely travel quite a distance on foot before they come across any proper mode of transport for their health needs. Even for our hospital team, drugs and other camp logistics had to be carried on foot for a distance of approximately 2 km to a maximum of 12 km.

Our camps were a huge relief to the villagers reeling under the seasonal health problems and illness and scared to venture out due to the ongoing COVID 19 pandemic and fear of hospitalization leading to isolation from their families if they visited any government hospital for consultation.

COMMUNITY MEDICAL CAMPS

Pipalkoti - Kimana Village Medical Camp - A highlight

Indomitable spirit to reach out the medically deprived population



For the first time ever, a medical team set foot on the remote Kimana village of block Joshimath on 27-05-2021, leaving the villagers amazed and full of gratitude. Braving the odds of treacherous hilly terrain and obstacles at multiple places, our team of dedicated professionals carrying the logistics and medicines, literally endangered their lives in reaching the venue which required a 12 km travel by foot. The road travel was equally dangerous as it passed through narrow stretches and sections where the roads were non-existent. The return journey was again full of risks but the indomitable spirit of our team failed to deter them from completing the task.

Pipalkoti hospital has been conducting medical camps in such inaccessible remote villages and sites so as to reach the deprived and needy especially during the COVID times. One of such medical camp was organized in the above mentioned village on the request of their Pradhan, Shri Mukesh Semwal.

He was deeply grateful and thanked the Doctors and paramedical staff of the hospital for organizing much needed camp in their village.

Apart from medical check-up, an awareness session was also provided to all the villagers regarding COVID-19 guidelines and protocols.

Madhav Hospital (Kedarnath Marg), Narayankoti

Total 4 camps catering to 4 villages were conducted with 167 beneficiaries

Narayankoti hospital organized 4 community medical camps in Byung, Andrawadi, Makko and Semi villages of block Ukhimath of Rudraprayag District. These camps were conducted between 25th to 28th and were held at sites ranging from a nearest distance of 8 km to a farthest of 36 km from our hospital.

The team has also conducted COVID diagnostic test (RAT and RT PCR) of beneficiaries in collaboration with the local government health department.

Haridwar

A suspected male COVID patient arrived at our hospital in respiratory distress with SPO2 level of 64% on room air and HRCT score as 21/25. Along with all the drugs and care, he was kept on a very high flow of Oxygen (24 lit/min).

Another suspected female COVID patient arrived at our hospital in respiratory distress with SPO2 level of 54%, her HRCT score was also 21/25. Along with all the drugs and care, she was similarly kept on a very high flow of Oxygen (24 lit/min).

Both the patients who were critical at the time of admission, recovered fully with our care and were discharged in normal and healthy condition .

A 70 yrs old male patient with SpO2: 65%, Pulse rate - 84/min, HRCT Score : 16/25

and

A 40 yrs old male patient with SpO2: 78%, and difficulty in breathing.

Both the patients who were critical at the time of admission, recovered fully with our care and were discharged in normal and healthy condition .

Narayankoti

A 3 years old baby was received in unconscious state on 17-05-2021 with active tonic - clonic seizure and blood stained vomiting. She had sustained injuries over head, abdomen and chest due to fall from height. At home the attendants had given liquids orally to the patient while she was semi conscious resulting in aspiration.

She was resuscitated and put on non invasive ventilation. Her seizure continued despite standard treatment, however she responded in an hour and half with dedicated care of our emergency team. After stabilizing patient was referred by our ambulance for further management.

On being followed up after few days, the patient was recovering well. She probably had concussion with aspiration pneumonia with blunt abdominal injury which was managed conservatively. The emergency staff's prompt and timely intervention once again saved a precious life.

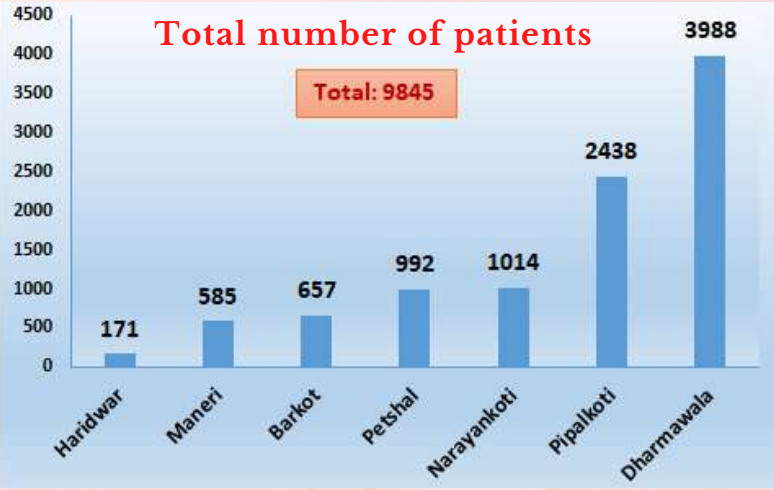

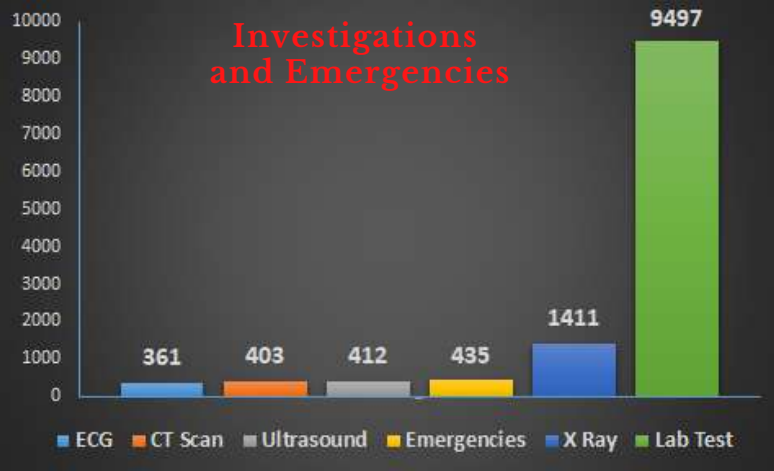


Haridwar OPD resumed routine OPD services from 26-05-2021 as before that the hospital was functioning as a Covid hospital.

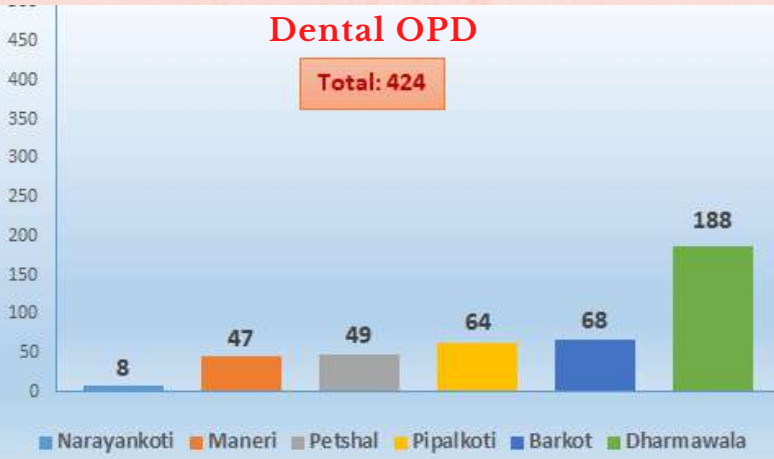
CT Scan facility is available only at Dharmawala hospital.

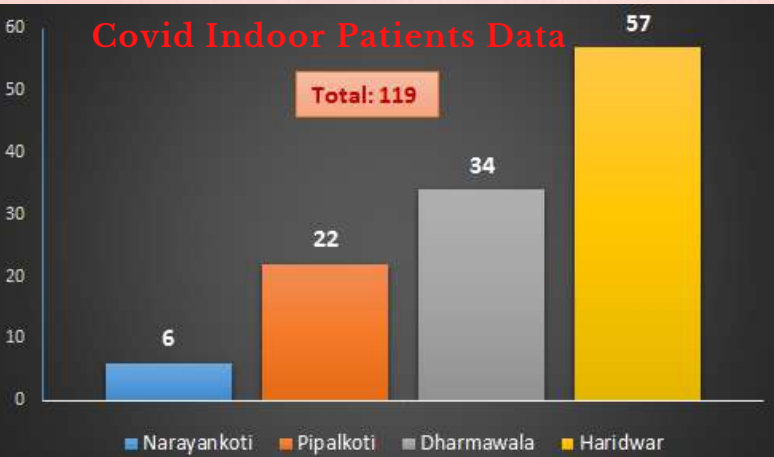
Dental OPD

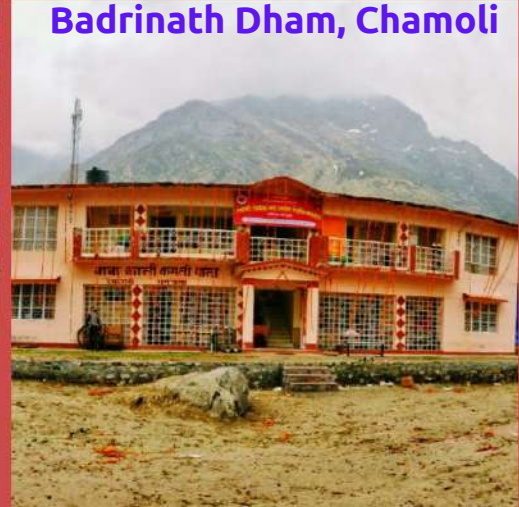
