HIGHLIGHTS OF THE MONTH

Sadhana Kendra Ashram is a spiritual centre founded by Shrichandra Swami Udasin ji for sincere and dedicated seekers of truth to practice meditation and spirituality. It is run by Seekers Trust, a spiritual and charitable organization founded by Swamiji in 1970. Along with its spiritual activities, the ashram has been serving the poor and the needy in many ways, especially in the areas of education and medical care. Ashram is running a charitable school, as well as a charitable hospital and in addition, does numerous charitable activities like free medical camps, aid and relief during natural calamities, repair and construction of houses for the poor, public utility works, financial support to needy students, distributing essential commodities and rations to the poor and destitute, running free vocational training programmes in sewing and computer education, coaching classes, etc. Noteworthy the ashram has been regularly helping our Society in various health programmes and initiatives.

As per Swamiji's kind wish, SVHM Society took over the functioning of the Udasinacharya Shrichandra Charitable Hospital of Sadhana Kendra Ashram, Dumet, Vikasnagar, Dehradun from 10th December 2021. The charitable hospital has a general OPD, a Dental wing, a well equipped laboratory and free pharmacy.
