The 3rd quarter literally paved the life to Pre-Covid era with the community freely engaging in all activities ranging from festival celebrations, tourism to religious and family functions get together. Another marked development was commencement of USG facility at Pipalkoti hospital thus making it the third hospital of the Society to do so. The facility will be of immense benefit to the local community thus enabling them to avail an advanced diagnostic facility.

A worthy notable feat was the daily patient load of Society's Shri Kedarnath Hospital which was above 350 and on one day it was above 1000. The heavy rush of patients tremendously justifies the Society's empyrean initiative of establishing the hospital at Kedarnath Dham.

Society's regular Community Medical camps and Hospital's Multidisciplinary and Super specialty camps kept on serving the humanity with the Doctors associated with the Society extending their voluntary services unabated.

Society decided to commemorate Swami Vivekanand Jayanti falling on 12th January by conducting a door to door "community interaction drive". The objective was to apprise the community about the thought behind formation of the Society, by whom it is being run and that it survives on donations by generous people from every walk of life. The drive also aimed to collect feedback about our services as well as donations from the community. The drive commenced in Dharmawala hospital from December while the other hospitals began in January 2022.
