The Society will always remain at the helm of charitable work and needs blessings and bankrolls from their well-wishers unabated.



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

OUR FOOTPRINTS



Founded in the year 2012 by a group of young Doctors and some philanthropists, Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is continuing its mission of providing high quality charitable health care to mankind. The Society started its journey by establishing their first charitable project in the form of a small dispensary at Dharmawala, a tribal dominated village, situated 40 km from Dehradun, Uttarakhand and bordering the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

The self-belief of the Society to provide quality health care to the deprived, tribes, pilgrims and needy along with strong willed approach led to establishment of more hospitals in phases as well as the up gradation of the small dispensary of Dharmawala to a full-fledged multi-specialty hospital. The Society with its vision and mission as the guiding principles also established charitable hospitals in three of the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand and presently the Society is running 11 charitable hospitals in the state of

Uttarakhand and the latest 12th hospital has become operational at Delhi.

The Society apart from its charitable hospitals is also involved in other philanthropic activities like conducting community medical camps in remote, hilly and difficult to reach areas (during COVID wave also), education activities, making community self-reliant via Swavalamban Abhiyaan and community health programmes which encompass five programs in itself (Anaemia Prevention and Control Programme, Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme, Menstrual Hygiene Programme, Community Mental Health Programme and Oral, Head and Neck Cancer Awareness, Screening and Treatment Programme.


The 'Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa' motto of the Society has been and will always be the essence of all our endeavours to serve humanity.

Highlights of this year

- All three hospitals surpassed the number of patients attended since their inception.
- Apart from medical services, the hospitals also provided free tea and biscuits as well as free slippers and raincoats to the needy pilgrims who, being unaware of the harsh weather conditions and terrain had to bear the hardships.
- Shri Kedarnath Dham hospital had the unique distinction of having catered to approximately 10% of total devotees who visited the pious shrine.

- Govt. of India acknowledged our selfless work, reached out to us, and nominated Society's Secretary Dr Anuj Singhal as a member in the Char Dham committee under PMO for overlooking and devising ways so that the devotees have a plain sailing during the Yatra.
- The hospitals had visits from a plethora of eminent personalities and dignitaries ranging from Hon'ble Governor of Uttarakhand, Director Health and Family Welfare, Govt of Uttarakhand to Shri Mukesh Ambani etc.
- There was a moment to be proud of when Society's Dham hospitals were entrusted with the responsibility of providing health and medical cover to Shri Mukesh Ambani who was on a visit to the holy shrines of Shri Badrinath Dham and Shri Kedarnath Dham.


The Road Ahead





Success Stories

Dharmawala Reached landmark of 50 Spine Surgeries

- Spine surgery department was started in Feb 2022 under
 Dr Tejasvi Agarwal and first spinal surgery was done on 26th Feb 2022.
- Further, with support of Dr Tejasvi and overall guidance of Dr Shekhar Y Bhojraj of The Spine Foundation, Mumbai the SVHM Society entered into a partnership with the Foundation with the aim to provide high quality spinal care facility at Dharmawala hospital.
- The Spine Foundation is a pioneer in providing rural spine care throughout India, which makes our hospital also a Rural Spine Care Center.
- Dharmawala has successfully conducted more than 50 spine surgeries with no major post-surgery complications and treated more than 1500 patients with spinal disorders on OPD basis.
- Additionally to ensure that patients from weaker sections and from tribal, hilly and inaccessible areas of the community reach us and avail this facility, our staff were also apprised about all the "red flags" related to spinal ailments.





Spine Surgery Underway



Barkot

- A one and half year old male child presented in our OPD on 16th Nov with complaint of injury over left leg due to fall leading to fracture of his left thigh bone (femur).
- The child was given a hip Spica one leg cast after closed reduction under the guidance of an Orthopaedician.
- On follow up, the fracture had healed and fused completely.
- What makes this case special was availability of such a facility at a remote and hilly place!


- A 28 years old male patient presented in ENT OPD on 17th July with complaints of recurrent discharge and ringing/buzzing sound from his right ear for the last 4 months and despite having taken treatment at several other clinics was not cured.
- Not responding to routine treatment, the patient's ear pus sample was sent for microbiological examination for tuberculosis which was then confirmed.
- Patient was put on DOTS therapy for TB and after 3 months, right cortical Mastoidectomy with type 3 tympanoplasty surgeries were done successfully on 17th October.
- On follow up the patient was cured of his ailments and thanked the Society and hospital for the same.
- What makes this case special was correct diagnosis which was missed by previous clinics he consulted!





