From the Editor's Desk

The second quarter of this year added yet another milestone in the illustrious journey of SVHM Society when the cataract and other eye surgery facilities commenced at its Dharmawala hospital thus fulfilling a long-standing unmet need of the patients. Alongside this was the spine departments' mega achievement of attaining the figure of 200 surgeries which included several advanced and complex procedures.

The visit of Kirti Chakra, Shaurya Chakra and Vishisht Sewa Medal awardee Colonel Ajay Kothiyal to our Narayankoti hospital was an honour and privilege for us. The presence of such a decorated officer and his words of praise and appreciation for the SVHM Society and the hospital facilities was a moment to behold for all of us.

The Dham hospitals of the Society kept serving the devotees with supreme dedication and diligence. One noteworthy happening was an unfortunate accident of a minibus which took place 4 km before Shri Badrinath Dham. Since no ambulance was available with the local authorities, they approached us and within no time our Shri Badrinath Hospital ambulance and team reached the site, attended to the injured by giving first aid and then brought them to our hospital for further management thus saving precious lives.

Dharmawala hospital became equipped with a Hearse van thus making available a facility which will help the grief-stricken families to ferry the deceased to the cremation ground with respect and dignity.

In another cherishable and divine moment, the outgoing Chief Priest of Shri Badrinath Dham, Shri Ishwar Prasad Namboothiri convened the Doctors and Staff of Shri Badrinath Dham hospital to his residence to convey his appreciation, gratitude and thankfulness for the services being rendered in the Dhams by the SVHM Society.

In response to the nationwide strike call from Indian Medical Association, the Society hospitals stood together with the medical fraternity and suspended their services barring emergencies for one day on the 17th of August to protest against the tragic incident of rape and murder of a Doctor at R G Kar Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata. A two-minutes silence was observed in the memory of the late Doctor as well as a candle march was also held to demand justice and punish the culprits.

The quarter had its own share of festivities and celebrations, namely Shri Krishan Janmashtami, Independence Day, Guru Poornima, Raksha Bandhan, Harela etc. Other functions included anniversary celebrations of Society hospitals of Petshal, Dharmawala and Barkot.

With the grace and blessings of Prabhu Shri Ram, SVHM Society family is expanding and enlarging with new trailblazers of humanity joining the Society bandwagon to serve and realise the philanthropists in them. The Society bows down to all their benefactors and patrons for helping us in realising and envisaging our motto of "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" ("Service to Humanity is Service to God").

Founded in the year 2012 by a group of young Doctors and some philanthropists, Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is continuing its mission of providing high quality charitable health care to mankind. The Society started its journey by establishing their first charitable project in the form of a small clinic at Dharmawala, a tribal dominated village, situated 40 km from Dehradun, Uttarakhand and bordering the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

The self-belief of the Society to provide quality health care to the deprived, tribal, pilgrims and needy along with strong willed approach led to establishment of more hospitals in phases as well as the up gradation of the small clinic of Dharmawala to a full-fledged multi-specialty hospital.

The Society with its vision and mission as the guiding principles also established charitable hospitals in the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand. These fully free hospitals are at Shri Badrinath Dham, Shri Kedarnath Dham and Gangotri Dham and are fully equipped with ICU facilities with staff trained in dealing with the problems of high altitude. The vast number of pilgrims visiting these shrines from all over the world used to

suffer because of non-availability of quality health care and the morbidity and mortality at these shrines was worrying, the establishment of Society's hospital at these Dhams brought down the rates by 90%. Presently, 14 charitable hospitals are being run by the Society, of which 11 are in Uttarakhand, two are in Uttar Pradesh and one is in Delhi.

The Society apart from its charitable hospitals is also involved in other philanthropic activities like conducting community medical camps in remote, hilly and difficult to reach areas (during COVID wave also), education activities, making community self-reliant via Swavalamban Abhiyaan and community health programmes which encompasses five programmes in itself, Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme, Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme, Menstrual Hygiene Programme, Community Mental Health Programme and Oral, Head and Neck Cancer Awareness, Prevention and Treatment Programme.

The "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" motto of the Society has been and will always remain the essence of all our endeavours to serve humanity.

Dharmawala: Regular Spine and Uro Surgery Camps

Periodic Spine Surgery Camp at Dharmawala: Organized in association with The Spine Foundation, Mumbai (TSF) and HOPE (Helping Old People Everywhere) Foundation, Dehradun

The biannual camp conducted successfully from 27th to 29th September had the presence of eminent and renowned Dr. Shekhar Y Bhojraj, Trustee and Senior Spine Surgeon of TSF and his team of six spine surgeons and one anaesthetist. Other members present in the camp were Mrs. Archana Bhojraj and her team.

Organized in joint collaboration of SVHM Society, TSF and HOPE Foundation, a total of eight spine surgeries were performed in this charitable camp, of which two were extremely complex, Atlanto-axial dislocation with compression and congenital Kyphoscoliosis. Both these surgeries, which are usually performed in tertiary care hospitals only and cost more than Rs. 10 lakhs, were performed completely free of cost. SVHM Society is immensely grateful to TSF and HOPE Foundation for their kind support and charitable endeavours. **Additionally, another moment to boast was reaching the figure of 200 spine surgeries by the department.**

Dharmawala: Fortnightly Urology Camp

Urology camps are organized at SVHM Society run Dharmawala Hospital on the second and fourth Sunday of every month in which a team of eminent Urologists from Delhi/Agra and other places offer their expertise and grace. These fortnightly camps have been providing the populace of Dharmawala as well as of far off remote, hilly, tribal and underserved areas, a facility which is available only in tertiary care hospitals located in cities. These pose a huge financial burden to the poor and needy community, and they often live with the illness if not treated. In this quarter, a total of 100 Uro surgeries were successfully performed by the team of Urologists. These included many complex and latest advanced procedures which are performed only in a few big hospitals and their cost is also very high and beyond the reach of the people hailing from low socio-economic strata.

All the injured patients, including 8 seriously injured patients, were managed and precious lives were saved.

Other Free Services

The platter of free services at our Dham hospitals apart from critical healthcare services includes provision of blankets, woollen track suits and pants, socks, caps, providing warmth by means of heaters and bonfires, raincoats, slippers as well as hot tea and biscuits.

In this quarter a total of

- 809 blankets,
- 567 woollen socks,
- 509 Monkey Caps,
- 378 woollen track suits,
- 295 pairs of slippers,
- 164 woollen track pants,
- 132 raincoats,
- more than 4000 protein energy bars and
- more than 20000 tea and biscuits were distributed.

The weather conditions in these Char Dhams often change suddenly and the environment becomes unfavourable from favourable in a short period. Many pilgrims, especially from the southern and western states of Bharat are unaware of the inclement weather conditions and come unprepared without any woollen clothing. They then face difficulties and lack of availability of woollen clothing makes their pilgrimage arduous and challenging, here our hospitals pitch in and provide solace by providing these needy pilgrims with blankets, woollen clothing, warm environment, slippers, hot tea and biscuits etc. free and with an unpretentious gesture.

Char Dham Services: New Hospital Project

Under Construction New 50 bedded Hospital at Shri Kedarnath Dham

SVHM Society has been running ICU equipped absolutely free hospitals in the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand and catering to the health needs of lakhs of devotees coming for pilgrimage since the last 5 years. Society's hospital at Shri Kedarnath Dham has been doing the same since 2019. This ICU equipped 8 bedded facility situated at an altitude of 12000 feet has catered to more than 3.5 lakhs devotees since inception. The hospital attended to approximately 10,000 pilgrims in 2019, more than 11,000 in 2021, more than 1,13,000 in 2022, more than 1,16,000 in 2023 and has already attended more than 1 lakh this year till 30th September.

The present hospital functions in a temporary facility which has limited space and is increasingly finding it difficult to manage such a high patient load which is steadily rising year after year. Keeping in view and sensing further increase in the patient footfall, the Society is constructing a new advanced 50 bedded high altitude charitable hospital located just in front of the existing hospital and barely one km before the pious shrine. This new hospital will be equipped with latest and advanced equipment, will have three floors and will cater to the pilgrims in a more efficient and coherent manner. 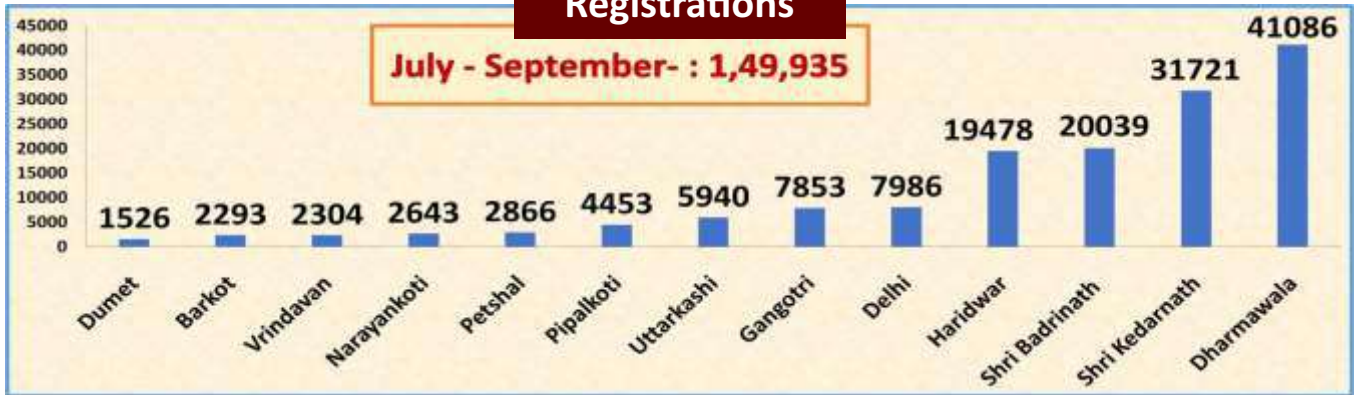

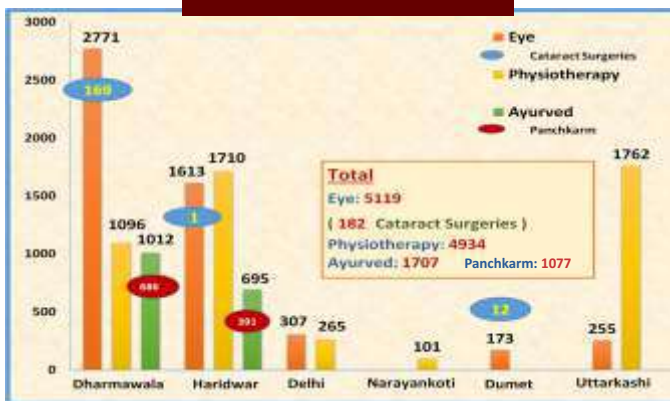

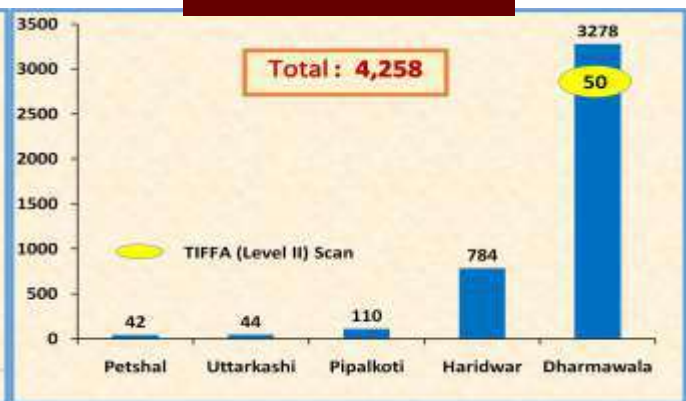
