From the Editor's Desk

Two marquee events held at Society's first hospital at Dharmawala made this year distinctive and heralded another era in the illustrious twelve-year-old journey of Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society. The twin grand occasions were the installation of pious Prabhu Shri Ram Darbar with complete ritualistic fervour and inauguration of the newly expanded building equipped with additional novel facilities and services. Dharmawala hospital has now evolved into a grand multidisciplinary and super specialty hospital housing many new facilities prominent among which are dialysis unit, ICU, new emergency block, integrated eye department, four modular operation theatres etc. thus providing a much-needed relief and succour for the residents of the remote, hilly, inaccessible and tribal areas and other regions spread across 100 km radius of the hospital.

Another proud feat was the commencement of OPD services and Sunday multi-disciplinary and super specialty camps in the 14th hospital of the Society established on the divine land of Vrindavan. The construction work of this 400-bedded super specialty hospital is in full progress and expected to be complete by next year. Society's zeal of broadening the horizons yielded another milestone at Pipalkoti hospital where Bhoomi Pujan ceremony was conducted for construction of a new five-storey hospital having additional facilities and disciplines. Some other new achievements were the start of Rheumatology OPD and surgeries for cataract and other eye ailments in Dharmawala hospital.

Repeating the feat like previous years, the Society's Char Dham hospitals served the healthcare and other needs of the devotees with full dedication and commitment. This year also around two lakh pilgrims received health care services in our Dham hospitals. In another progressive note, the construction work of the new Shri Kedarnath Dham hospital begun last year is nearing completion and with the supreme blessings of Baba Kedar, the Society hopes to start the hospital in the coming Char Dham Yatra season. With the construction of this three floor 50 bedded hospital the Society will be in a position to cater to a large number of pilgrims.

SVHM Society and its Secretary Dr Anuj Singhal getting honoured with two national level excellence awards was another prideful and rejoicing moment.

The Society is now entering its thirteenth year and is ready to make its charitable journey more glorious and memorable and is assured that we will continue to receive your continuous and uninterrupted support, companionship and love.

Founded in the year 2012 by a group of young Doctors and some philanthropists, Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is continuing its mission of providing high quality charitable health care to mankind. The Society started its journey by establishing their first charitable project in the form of a small clinic at Dharmawala, a tribal dominated village, situated 40 km from Dehradun, Uttarakhand and bordering the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

The self-belief of the Society to provide quality health care to the deprived, tribal, pilgrims and needy along with strong willed approach led to establishment of more hospitals in phases as well as the up gradation of the small clinic of Dharmawala to a full-fledged multi-specialty hospital.

The Society with its vision and mission as the guiding principles also established charitable hospitals in the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand. These fully free hospitals are at Shri Badrinath Dham, Shri Kedarnath Dham and Gangotri Dham and are fully equipped with ICU facilities with staff trained in dealing with the problems of high altitude. The vast number of pilgrims visiting these shrines from all over the world used to

suffer because of non-availability of quality health care and the morbidity and mortality at these shrines was worrying, the establishment of Society's hospital at these Dhams brought down the rates by 90%. Presently, 14 charitable hospitals are being run by the Society, of which 11 are in Uttarakhand, two are in Uttar Pradesh and one is in Delhi.

The Society apart from its charitable hospitals is also involved in other philanthropic activities like conducting community medical camps in remote, hilly and difficult to reach areas (during COVID wave also), education activities, making community self-reliant via Swavalamban Abhiyaan and community health programmes which encompasses five programmes in itself, Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme, Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme, Menstrual Hygiene Programme, Community Mental Health Programme and Oral, Head and Neck Cancer Awareness, Prevention and Treatment Programme.

The "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" motto of the Society has been and will always remain the essence of all our endeavours to serve humanity.

SVHM Society Participates in “Aakrosh” Rally Held at Dehradun against Atrocities on Hindus in Bangladesh

10th December 24: On the International Human Rights Day, an “Aakrosh” rally was organized in Dehradun to protest against the atrocities being committed on minorities, especially Hindus, under the aegis of the interim government of Bangladesh. SVHM Society extended their full support and more than 50 Doctors and staff from Dharmawala hospital aggregated at the venue with placards of message displaying their concerns in their hands, participated in the rally and registered their remonstrance. Society also initiated a signature campaign against these atrocities, a copy of which was sent to the Hon'ble President through the District Magistrate.



Netr Kumbh: Prayagraj

The Maha Kumbh organized in Prayagraj was world's largest public gathering and collective act of faith. This congregation, primarily, included Ascetics, Saints, Sadhus, Sadhis, Kalpvasis and Pilgrims from all walks of life and it became a Maha Kumbh not only of devotion and religious faith but also of service. SVHM Society in collaboration with other social service organizations together organized a Netr (Eye) Kumbh camp in an area spread over 8.5 acres in Sector 6 near the Nagvasuki temple on the banks of the river Ganga in Prayagraj. Netr Kumbh offered services and assistance to lakhs of visually impaired people coming for Maha Kumbh and rendered them with every possible eye related ailments treatment inclusive of free eye checkup, medicine and spectacles distribution. This 53-day Netr Kumbh activity organized from 6th January to 27th February 2025 was also

mentioned and praised by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi in one of his speeches. Dr. Praveen Reddy from SVHM Society was the Chief Medical Officer of this Netr Kumbh.

A summary of the activities carried out at Netr Kumbh is detailed below:

- Total optometrists who volunteered: 489
- Total volunteers: 2700
- Total eye patients who availed the facilities in the camp: 2,37,964
- Total spectacles distributed: 1,63,652
- Total Number of Patients diagnosed with Cataract and Referred: 20,501



Cataract and Other Eye Surgeries Commence at Dharmawala Hospital

28th July 24 became another historic date in the epic journey of Dharmawala hospital when first cataract surgery was conducted in the new operation theatre of its eye department. The advanced Phacoemulsification technique will greatly benefit the patients living in and around Dharmawala Hospital and those from remote tribal, inaccessible, backward and hilly areas. Also this makes available a much-needed facility for the cataract patients requiring surgery and thus addressing the most common cause of blindness in the community. Eye ailments of all kind are now being treated and surgeries being conducted in this new eye department located on the 4th floor of the new Dharmawala Hospital building. A total of 409 cataract and other operations were successfully completed this year.

Fortnightly Urology Camps

For the last eight years, regular Urology camps are being organized at Dharmawala Hospital on the second and last Sunday of every month. Teams of renowned Urologists from Delhi/Agra and other places come to offer their services and grace us. In this year, a total of 306 Uro surgeries were successfully performed in 25 camps. Many of these were complex and modern procedures which are performed only in a few big hospitals and their cost is also very high and beyond the reach of the low-income group.

1) Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme

SVHM Society ran this Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme with support from Uttarakhand Jal Vidyut Nigam Limited from October 2023 till September 2024. The programme was conducted in 14 villages across 6 tribal-dominated Gram Panchayats of Dehradun district and it yielded encouraging results, a summary of which is tabulated below.
