These fully free and round the clock operational hospitals at the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand have been rendering the pilgrims and the local populace with highest quality health care facilities and other ancillary services during the Char Dham Yatra season. This year too these hospitals reopened with traditional rituals and observances.

The Society was overwhelmed with joy when Society's Gangotri Dham hospital was visited by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttarakhand, Shri Pushkar Singh Dhami Ji who after reviewing the facilities and services was laudatory and appreciative. The Society feels privileged and expresses deep gratitude for his commendatory gesture.

A remarkable development was acceptance of Society's CSR proposal to the Airports Authority of India for the establishment of MRI and Digital Mammography units in Society run Dharmawala hospital. These twin facilities will impart significant benefits thus addressing healthcare disparities and improving patient outcomes in tribal and underserved catchment areas of Society's Dharmawala hospital. Additionally, it will eliminate the arduous and often expensive travel to distant urban centers thus reducing the physical, financial, and emotional strain on the needy patients and their families.

A major highlight of the quarter was selection of Society's Secretary Dr Anuj Singhal for the prestigious post of Chairman of the Ethical Committee of Uttarakhand Medical Council. Nomination of Dr Anuj for this distinguished post speaks volumes of his conscientious, assiduous and righteous image.

The quarter saw Society yet again collaborating with other philanthropic organizations in organizing three special surgery camps at Dharmawala hospital, first a spine camp organized in collaboration with The Spine Foundation, Mumbai and HOPE Foundation, Dehradun, second a urosurgery camp in collaboration with North Zone Chapter of Urological Society of India (NZUSI) and Uttarakhand Urology Society (UKUS) and third a surgery camp organized in collaboration with The Association of Surgeons of India (ASI) under the aegis of Association of Surgeons of India - Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand (UPASI) & Dehradun City Chapter.

Festivities of this quarter inclusive of events, anniversaries and festivals continued to be celebrated with all the Doctors and Staff participating in full vigour and jollity. The major among them were foundation day celebrations of Uttarkashi, Shri Badrinath Dham and Vrindavan hospitals. Founded in the year 2012 by a group of young Doctors and some philanthropists, Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is continuing its mission of providing high quality charitable health care to mankind. The Society started its journey by establishing their first charitable project in the form of a small clinic at Dharmawala, a tribal dominated village, situated 40 km from Dehradun, Uttarakhand and bordering the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

The self-belief of the Society to provide quality health care to the deprived, tribal, pilgrims and needy along with strong willed approach led to establishment of more hospitals in phases as well as the up gradation of the small clinic of Dharmawala to a full-fledged multi-specialty hospital.

The Society with its vision and mission as the guiding principles also established charitable hospitals in the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand. These fully free hospitals are at Shri Badrinath Dham, Shri Kedarnath Dham and Gangotri Dham and are fully equipped with ICU facilities with staff trained in dealing with the problems of high altitude. The vast number of pilgrims visiting these shrines from all over the world used to

suffer because of non-availability of quality health care and the morbidity and mortality at these shrines was worrying, the establishment of Society's hospital at these Dhams brought down the rates by 90%. Presently, 14 charitable hospitals are being run by the Society, of which 11 are in Uttarakhand, two are in Uttar Pradesh and one is in Delhi.

The Society apart from its charitable hospitals is also involved in other philanthropic activities like conducting community medical camps in remote, hilly and difficult to reach areas (during COVID wave also), education activities, making community self-reliant via Swavalamban Abhiyaan and community health programmes which encompasses five programmes in itself, Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme, Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme, Menstrual Hygiene Programme, Community Mental Health Programme and Oral, Head and Neck Cancer Awareness, Prevention and Treatment Programme.

The "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" motto of the Society has been and will always remain the essence of all our endeavours to serve humanity.

Special Medical Camps

Dharmawala Hospital: Regular Bi-Monthly Urosurgery Camps

For the last 8 years on the second and last Sundays of every month charitable urosurgery camps have been held regularly at the SVHM Society run Dharmawala hospital in which teams of renowned urologists from Delhi, Agra, and various other states and cities across India visit the hospital to provide their selfless services and expertise. The aims of these camps are to provide accessible and affordable healthcare, especially to underserved populations.

In this quarter a total of 50 uro-surgeries were successfully performed in 6 camps by the team of elite Urologists. Many of these surgeries involved complex and modern procedures that are typically only available in a few large hospitals and are very expensive, making them inaccessible to low-income groups.



Dharmawala Hospital: Eye Surgery Camps

The Eye Department of Swami Vivekanand Charitable Hospital, Dharmawala is functioning on the fourth floor of the new building and is equipped with all types of modern and latest equipment and facilities and is conducting all types of eye surgeries inclusive of cataract.

Eye surgeon Professor Dr. Rajkumar Gupta gave his invaluable contribution in these camps organized in this quarter. Professor Dr. Rajkumar Gupta is the Head of the Ophthalmology Department in Government Medical College Pilibhit, Uttar Pradesh and visits last Sunday of every month to provide his selfless service and expertise.

A total of 62 Cataract and other Eye Surgeries were successfully performed in this quarter.

Petshal Hospital: Eye Camps

Those patients who needed cataract and other eye surgeries were referred to Almora Medical College and were provided full support and assistance.





Special Medical Camps

Barkot Hospital: Orthopaedic Camp

Dr Pawan Garg, MS Ortho, provided his invaluable services in this five-day special Orthopaedics camp organized at Swami Vivekanand Charitable Hospital Barkot from 3rd to 7th of April. Beneficiaries from nearby and distant hilly areas of Barkot reached this camp in large numbers to get treatment for their Ortho and muscle related problems.

A total of 137 patients were examined in this camp.



Narayankoti Hospital: Medical Camp

Physician Dr. Santosh Kumar Sharma, MBBS, MD, MCCP provided his selfless medical services in this five-day special camp organized at Madhav Hospital, Narayankoti from 1st to 5th of June. Special Surgery Camps are regularly organized in every month at Madhav Hospital, Narayankoti in which General and Laparoscopic Surgeon Dr. M.M. Hamidi, Orthopaedic Surgeon Dr. Kapil Tyagi and Anaesthetist Dr. Chanchal from Yatharth Hospital, Noida provide their invaluable and specialized services. In this quarter, a total of 18 surgeries inclusive of difficult and complex were successfully performed.



Pipalkoti Hospital: Surgery Camp

Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is regularly organizing special surgery camps every month at Swami Vivekanand Charitable Hospital at Pipalkoti to provide excellent surgical facilities to the beneficiaries of nearby and distant hilly areas. Due to these camps, patients do not have to travel far off to other urban centers.

In this quarter Dr. Vaibhav Pratap Singh, General Surgeon and Dr. C.B. Verma, Senior Anaesthetist from Dharmawala Hospital, provided their valuable services in the camp.



Char Dham Hospitals Services

Like every year, this year too, with the opening of the pious Char Dham Shrines, Society's three Dham hospitals reopened for the season with holding of traditional havan, rituals and ceremonies. Success Stories

"Where service becomes a resolve, there faith is born..."

We were a group of 12 people from Mumbai who had set out on a pilgrimage to Shri Kedarnath Dham. Some of us came from Gaurikund on mules and porters, while four of us took the difficult trek on foot. Exhausted, when we finally reached near the temple around 7:30 in the evening, we saw a large board – Swami Vivekanand Charitable Hospital – it read, Free medical services available here.

Out of curiosity, we went to the hospital. I had pain in my neck, my friend was experiencing stomach discomfort, and my son was facing difficulty in breathing. We didn't have to wait in a queue. There were no formalities. The team of doctors and nurses immediately began attending to us. My neck was examined and I was given medicines. My friend received high-quality medication for his stomach, and my son was given oxygen and treatment immediately.

"Where love exists in treatment, faith works more than the medicine."

We were overwhelmed by what we saw — at such a high altitude, in such extreme conditions, such a powerful and compassionate medical center — and that too, completely free of charge! The medicines weren't ordinary — they were known branded ones, expensive.

"Every doctor, every nurse here is working like an angel."

Not once did we see fatigue on anyone's face, nor any sign of irritation. Every person was serving us as if we were their own family. Like a mother's care, a friend's understanding, and a teacher's guidance — that was the atmosphere there.

I earnestly appeal to all my fellow countrymen — to donate and support a service-oriented trust like Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society, Uttarakhand, and help it reach every home. This trust is a beacon of hope for those who are deprived of healthcare due to economic, social, or geographical reasons.

"True service is that which comes at the right time, and true compassion is that which touches the heart..."

I am **Bakul Vyas**, a resident of Mumbai. I recently undertook a sacred pilgrimage to Shri Kedarnath Dham. My heart was filled with devotion, but the Almighty chose to test me a little along the way. It was an extremely crowded day, and just as I stepped forward to get a VIP darshan ticket, I suddenly fell from a height of about four and a half feet and was seriously injured. The pain was unbearable, and for a moment, fear gripped my heart — what will happen now, at such an altitude, in this remote mountain terrain?

"When life wavers, it is the comforting touch of someone's care that becomes your true support..."

Someone immediately took me to the Swami Vivekanand Charitable Hospital, Shri Kedarnath Dham. And that's where a remarkable experience began — one that words alone cannot fully capture. As soon as I arrived, there were no slips to fill, no formalities to complete — the doctors and staff, immersed in the spirit of service, immediately got to work on my treatment. No one asked, "Where are you from?" or "Do you have money?" They only asked, "Where is the injury?"

Having worked in the pharmaceutical industry since 1978, I have spent a significant portion of my life visiting hospitals, medical facilities, and industries across India. But I have never seen such promptness, such sensitivity, and

such heartfelt care anywhere. There was no ego in the doctors' eyes, no delay — only one goal: "Treat the patient immediately and bring them relief."

"When compassion is woven into medicine, it is no longer service — it becomes worship."

I had an injury in my left leg. An X-ray was immediately done — on the bed itself — which confirmed a fracture. A cast was applied, and I was given medicines — all of it completely free of cost. I was stunned. This place isn't just a hospital — in the truest sense, it is a temple of service.

With all my heart, I bow to the efforts of the Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society, whose inspiration and tireless commitment have made such divine medical service possible even at such a high altitude and under challenging conditions. In the end, I would only say —

We had come from Andhra Pradesh for the Char Dham Yatra. While enroute to the Yamunotri Dham shrine at Barkot halt, my mother became unwell. She was in the hotel, and her condition became critical. We were panicked — because at such a high altitude, in such a remote location, getting urgent medical help seemed nearly impossible.

We rushed her to the Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society's hospital in Barkot. And the experience we had there was simply incredible. The hospital staff immediately took charge of my mother. Just half an hour before, she had been unable to speak — and now, she was talking normally. She personally thanked the doctors with folded hands.

I was overwhelmed seeing how, even in such adverse conditions — a remote Himalayan region with limited resources — the doctors, nurses, and the entire staff were tirelessly and fearlessly committed to serving. This isn't just a hospital — it's a lifeline for countless individuals who may encounter crises during their spiritual journey.

Today, my mother is fine. Her smile has returned. Words fall short to express the gratitude I feel towards this mission.

Thank you, from the depth of my soul.






