## From the Editor's Desk

Continuing the momentum this quarter too was adorned with several achievements and innovations for Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society.

The prime accomplishment of the quarter was when Society dedicated another new charitable hospital at Lal Dhang, Haridwar to the community thus increasing the number of their charitable hospitals to fifteen. The Health Centre, located 30 km away from Haridwar has been named Raja Jagatdev Singh Memorial Hospital and is in a forest area with Buksa tribe as the primary inhabitants. The hospital will prove to be highly beneficial for the underprivileged residents of this backward and neglected region.

A divine happening of this quarter was the hoisting (Dhwaj Arohan) of the holy flag of Prabhu Hanuman atop the Mrityunjay Mahadev Temple of Dharmawala hospital on the holy day of Prabhu Shri Ram-Janaki Vivaah Panchami on the 25th of November. This sacred ceremony enveloped the entire hospital in an aura of sanctity, as devotees paid obeisance to the revered holy flag.

Another key achievement was of the Orthopaedic Department of Dharmawala hospital's first successful total knee replacement surgeries, performed on four patients on the very first day. Offered at a nominal cost, this complex procedure promises to be a boon for patients from socially and economically backward strata.

With the aim of expanding and updating the knowledge and skills of its doctors and staff, the Society has been organizing CME workshops regularly. Two such national level workshops were successfully conducted at Dharmawala Hospital in this quarter; the first one was an Advanced Nursing Workshop in Critical Care held on the 3rd and 4th of November and the second one was Point of Care Ultrasound (POCUS) in Critical Care and Echocardiography held on the 13th and 14th of December.

The Society maintains its therapeutic and curative services alongside disease prevention efforts. As part of these initiatives, a one-day free vaccination camp was successfully held at Dharmawala hospital on October 5th, administering cervical cancer vaccine to adolescents aged 9-20 years for protection against cervical cancer. This event marked a key achievement for the quarter.

Festivals of Vijayadashami, Sharad Purnima and Deepawali were celebrated with great joy and tradition during this quarter and these precious moments further strengthened the sense of camaraderie and kinship in the Society family.

The Society has long integrated extracurricular activities to foster key skills like discipline, perseverance, and leadership among staff, while cultivating a positive workplace. Doctors and staff alike joined in with great excitement and enthusiasm, proudly displaying their cricketing skills in the second cricket league held in the last week of December at Dharmawala hospital.

The Society family extends its humble salutations to all its well-wishers and benefactors and is upbeat that the coming quarter will again bring more new achievements and accomplishments.

Founded in the year 2012 by a group of young Doctors and some philanthropists, Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is continuing its mission of providing high quality charitable health care to mankind. The Society started its journey by establishing their first charitable project in the form of a small clinic at Dharmawala, a tribal dominated village, situated 40 km from Dehradun, Uttarakhand and bordering the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

The self-belief of the Society to provide quality health care to the deprived, tribal, pilgrims and needy along with strong willed approach led to establishment of more hospitals in phases as well as the up gradation of the small clinic of Dharmawala to a full-fledged multi-specialty hospital.

The Society with its vision and mission as the guiding principles also established charitable hospitals in the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand. These fully free hospitals are at Shri Badrinath Dham, Shri Kedarnath Dham and Gangotri Dham and are fully equipped with ICU facilities with staff trained in dealing with the problems of high altitude. The vast number of pilgrims visiting these shrines from all over the world used to

suffer because of non-availability of quality health care and the morbidity and mortality at these shrines was worrying, the establishment of Society's hospital at these Dhams brought down the rates by 90%. Presently, fifteen charitable hospitals are being run by the Society, of which twelve are in Uttarakhand, two are in Uttar Pradesh and one is in Delhi.

The Society apart from its charitable hospitals is also involved in other philanthropic activities like conducting community medical camps in remote, hilly and difficult to reach areas (during COVID wave also), education activities, making community self-reliant via Swavalamban Abhiyaan and community health programmes which encompasses five programmes in itself, Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme, Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme, Menstrual Hygiene Programme, Community Mental Health Programme and Oral, Head and Neck Cancer Awareness, Prevention and Treatment Programme.

The "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" motto of the Society has been and will always remain the essence of all our endeavours to serve humanity.



# Highlights of the Quarter

## Dharmawala Hospital: Free Cervical Vaccination Programme

On October 5th 2025, a free cervical vaccination camp was organized at SVHM Society run Dharmawala hospital in collaboration with Rotary Club in which a total of 466 adolescent girls aged 9 to 20 yrs from Dharmawala and nearby backward and tribal villages were vaccinated thus protecting them from cervical cancer. In addition to cervical cancer, this vaccine also provides protection against anal, vaginal, and throat cancers. This vaccine is also crucial for young boys as it prevents HPV-related cancers, such as penile, anal, and throat cancers, as well as genital warts. This protects boys themselves and reduces the spread of infection to

future partners, thereby strengthening protection against cervical cancer in women through herd immunity.

The programme's objective was to increase health awareness among the younger generation, especially adolescent girls, and to provide them with timely protection against cervical and other cancers. The camp also served a forum for the adolescent girls to receive health-related information from experts. Doctors and staff from Dharmawala hospital, Rotary club functionaries, their associated doctors, and social workers were also present on this occasion.

## Dharmawala Hospital: First Successful Total Knee Replacement Surgery

Dharmawala Hospital added another outstanding achievement to its proud legacy when, on December 14, 2025, for the first time, four Total Knee Replacement surgeries were successfully performed simultaneously by team of Dr. Anil Juyal, Head of the Department of Orthopaedics at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun and Dr. Abhishek Gupta, Orthopaedic Surgeon at Dharmawala Hospital. While a single Total Knee Replacement surgery typically costs at least 1.5 to 2 lakh rupees, the cost borne by each

patient, including the implant, was only 30,000 rupees, with the remaining entire expense borne by the SVHM Society.

Total knee replacement surgery is a procedure that restores a quality lifestyle for patients suffering from severe arthritis and degenerative joint diseases. By offering this modern surgery at a minimal cost, the hospital is continuously striving to provide high-quality healthcare to the economically disadvantaged sections of society, with ease and convenience.

The fifteenth hospital of the Society, Raja Jagatdev Singh Memorial Hospital, Lal Dhang, Haridwar was formally inaugurated on November 1st 2025 by Shri Shri 1008 Mahamandaleshwar Swami Rupendra Prakash Ji Maharaj and Shri Dalchand Ji, Kshetriye Sangathan Mantri, Akhil Bharatiye Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram. This facility has been established through the collaborative efforts of Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram and SVHM Society.

The hospital located 30 kilometres from Haridwar city, is in the forest area having Buksa tribe as the main dwellers of this backward and underserved region. Currently, the hospital is operating as a day care centre and is also conducting multi-specialty camps on the first Sunday of every month.




