Tally of Society hospitals rising to fifteen with the inauguration of the latest hospital at Laldhang, Haridwar was the standout feature for this year. Dharmawala hospital finds a special mention this year with a plethora of new facilities and services decorating the platter namely addition of MRI, Cath Lab, and Digital Mammography facilities, commencement of Hip and Knee replacement surgeries, availability of full time Urologist, Retinal Surgeon and Pulmonologist and start of designated days OPD of Nephrology, Oncology, Endocrinology, Paediatric Cardiology, Diabetology & Plastic Surgery. Society's Char Dham hospitals continued their services indefatigably with this year recording highest patient footfall.

A divine happening which venerated the year was hoisting (Dhwaj Arohan) of the holy flag of Prabhu Hanuman atop the Mrityunjay Mahadev Temple of Dharmawala hospital. Society celebrated the 162nd birth anniversary of Swami Vivekanand at Dehradun in a majestic way which saw an attendance of more than 1200 participants inclusive of several revered personages and luminaries.

Few august events of the year were selection of Dr Anuj Singhal for the prestigious post of Chairman of the Ethical Committee of Uttarakhand Medical Council and Conferring of Samanvay Samman to Dr Anuj Singhal and Dr Tarashree Singhal by Samanvay Seva Trust, Bharat Mata Mandir, Haridwar.

Founded in the year 2012 by a group of young Doctors and some philanthropists, Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society is continuing its mission of providing high quality charitable health care to mankind. The Society started its journey by establishing their first charitable project in the form of a small clinic at Dharmawala, a tribal dominated village, situated 40 km from Dehradun, Uttarakhand and bordering the states of Himachal Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

The self-belief of the Society to provide quality health care to the deprived, tribal, pilgrims and needy along with strong willed approach led to establishment of more hospitals in phases as well as the up gradation of the small clinic of Dharmawala to a full-fledged multi-disciplinary and super specialty hospital.

The Society with its vision and mission as the guiding principles also established charitable hospitals in the Char Dhams of the state of Uttarakhand. These fully free hospitals are at Shri Badrinath Dham, Shri Kedarnath Dham and Gangotri Dham and are fully equipped with ICU facilities with staff trained in dealing with the problems of high altitude. The vast number of pilgrims visiting these shrines from all over the world used to

suffer because of non-availability of quality health care and the morbidity and mortality at these shrines was worrying, the establishment of Society's hospital at these Dhams brought down the rates by 90%. Presently, fifteen charitable hospitals are being run by the Society, of which twelve are in Uttarakhand, two are in Uttar Pradesh and one is in Delhi.

The Society apart from its charitable hospitals is also involved in other philanthropic activities like conducting community medical camps in remote, hilly and difficult to reach areas (during COVID wave also), education activities, making community self-reliant via Swavalamban Abhiyaan and community health programmes which encompasses five programmes in itself, Anaemia Prevention, Control and Treatment Programme, Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme, Menstrual Hygiene Programme, Community Mental Health Programme and Oral, Head and Neck Cancer Awareness, Prevention and Treatment Programme.

The "Nar Sewa Narayan Sewa" motto of the Society has been and will always remain the essence of all our endeavours to serve humanity.

Dharmawala Hospital: Free HPV Vaccination Programme

On 5th October 2025, a free HPV (Human Papillomavirus) vaccination camp was organized at SVHM Society run Dharmawala hospital in collaboration with Rotary Club in which a total of 466 adolescent girls aged 9 to 20 years from Dharmawala and nearby backward and tribal villages were vaccinated thus protecting them from cervical cancer. Doctors and staff from Dharmawala hospital, Rotary club functionaries, their associated doctors, and several social workers were also present on this occasion.

Dharmawala Hospital: First Successful Total Knee Replacement Surgery

Dharmawala Hospital added another outstanding achievement to its proud legacy when, on 14th December 2025, for the first time, four Total Knee Replacement surgeries were successfully performed simultaneously by team of Dr. Anil Juyal, Head of the Department of Orthopaedics at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun and Dr. Abhishek Gupta, Orthopaedic Surgeon at Dharmawala Hospital. While a single Total Knee Replacement surgery typically costs at least 1.5 to 2 lakh rupees, the cost borne by each patient, including the implant, was only ₹ 30,000 with the remaining entire expense borne by the SVHM Society.

The fifteenth hospital of the Society, Raja Jagatdev Singh Memorial Hospital, Laldhang, Haridwar was formally inaugurated on 1st November 2025 by Shri Shri 1008 Mahamandaleshwar Swami Rupendra Prakash Ji Maharaj and Shri Dalchand Ji, Kshetriye Sangathan Mantri, Akhil Bharatiye Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram. This facility has been established through the collaborative efforts of Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram and SVHM Society.

The hospital located 30 kilometres from Haridwar city, is in the forest area having Buksa tribe as the main dwellers of this backward and underserved region. Currently, the hospital is operating as a day care centre and is also conducting multi-specialty camps on the first Sunday of every month.

Society's Team Conducting Relief and Rescue Camps

A catastrophic flash flood swept away homes, bridges, roads, and claimed human lives at Dharaali in Uttarkashi, Uttarakhand, on the 5th August 2025. Responding without delay, the Society, through its Gangotri Dham hospital dispatched a team to the disaster zone. The team endured a strenuous trek for several km across flooded and damaged terrain to reach the affected area and provided crucial medical aid both at relief camps and through mobile outreach, stopping and treating survivors wherever they were sheltered.

- **Total Camps held at Dharaali Village: 19** - makeshift camps, while the random subjective camps were many times more
- **Total Patients: 452**

- **Total Camps at Neighbouring villages / hamlets: 3**
- **Total Patients: 54**

- **Total Medical treatment to pilgrims rescued by helicopter: 26**

In SVHM Society Gangotri Dham Hospital

- **Underwent admission: 40**
- **Underwent Day care: 506**

Ongoing Camp: Delhi

Held during one of the holiest months of the Hindu calendar, Shravan the Kanwar Yatra is a major annual pilgrimage on foot undertaken by devotees of Lord Shiva (Kanwariyas). Devotees walk miles carrying holy water from Haridwar, Gomukh, Gangotri, or other banks of the Ganges River to offer it to the Shivalinga at their local Shiva temples. Residential Outreach Health Camps

Uttarakhand's peculiar topography makes several regions inaccessible and unreachable resulting in huge unmet need regarding healthcare and other basic amenities. To reach these underserved areas, a significant amount of time is consumed in transit due to the mountainous terrain and hilly landscapes. Society has been addressing this lacuna by organizing residential camps in these regions. These drives have successfully fulfilled the objective of providing health services to regions devoid of basic medical facilities and accessing the inaccessible sections of the community. The teams reside for 2 – 3 days as per the need in these mountainous, healthcare-deficient, and highly inaccessible region delivering quality health check-ups, diagnostic investigations and treatment.

·Barkot hospital conducted a three-day rural remote health camp from 20th to 22nd December 2025 across 8 villages in the remote Phateparvat region of Mori Block. Access to this underdeveloped area situated at an altitude of 7,000 feet and 103 km from the hospital, necessitated traversal of multiple rugged, uneven, and deteriorated roads, with the final one km undertaken on foot. Total beneficiaries: 642.

·Pipalkoti Hospital also organized such 3 rural remote health camps;

- On January 30th – 31st 2026, a one-day camp each at Pokhta and Kanakchauri Villages of Pokhari Block located at a distance of 81 and 86 km from Pipalkoti hospital respectively. Total beneficiaries: 274.
- On March 26th -27th 2026, a two-day camp at Ravigram village of Joshi Math block located at a distance of 45 km from Pipalkoti hospital. Total beneficiaries :349.
- On March 29th – 30th March 2026, a two-day camp at remote border village Sheetal of Nandanagar block located at a distance of 52 km from Pipalkoti hospital. Total beneficiaries: 233



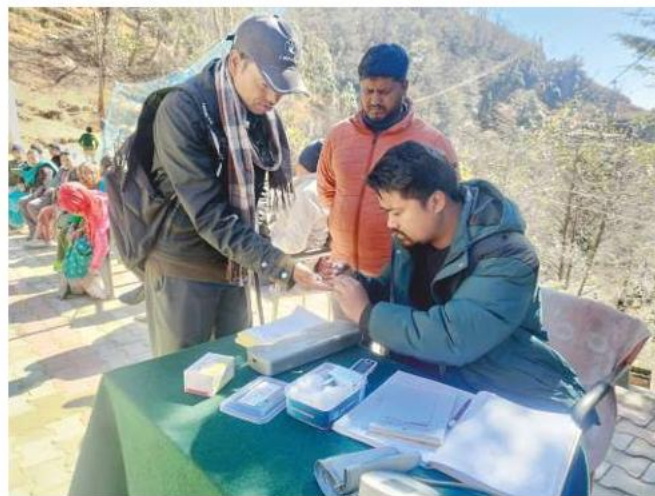
